

Short Study No. 14, Christ Jesus was Already the Mediator Before the Incarnation

Jesus Christ, the Mediator, as the Man of God's Right Hand, Before the Incarnation

King David saw the *MAN OF GOD'S RIGHT HAND*. the God-Man, Christ Jesus.

Psalms 80:17 Let thy hand be upon the man of thy *right hand*, upon the son of man *whom* thou madest strong for thyself.

This is both wonderful and marvelous, but more follows.

Psalms 17:7 Shew thy marvellous loving kindness, O thou that savest by thy right hand them which put their trust *in thee* from those that rise up *against them*.

Psalms 20:6 Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed; he will hear him from his holy heaven with the saving strength of his right hand.

Psalms 21:8 Thine hand shall find out all thine enemies: thy right hand shall find out those that hate thee.

Psalms 48:10 According to thy name, O God, so *is* thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness.

Psalms 77:10 And I said, This *is* my infirmity: *but I will remember* the years of the right hand of the most High.

Psalms 78:54 And he brought them to the border of his sanctuary, *even to* this mountain, *which* his right hand had purchased.

Psalms 89:13 Thou hast a mighty arm: strong is thy hand, *and* high is thy right hand.

Psalms 110:1 <<A Psalm of David.>> The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Psalms 110:5 The Lord at thy right hand shall strike through kings in the day of his wrath.

Psalms 118:15 The voice of rejoicing and salvation *is* in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Psalms 118:16 The right hand of the LORD is exalted: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.

Christ is plainly *Identified* in the New Testament as Being in the Exalted Position of the Only Mediatorial Judge

The glories of Christ as the Mediatorial-Judge are not new. He did not serve in this office *ONLY AFTER HIS RESURRECTION AND ASCENSION*. This He was already doing in the O. T. era.

Matthew 22:44 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

Matthew 26:64 Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Mark 14:62 And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Luke 20:42 And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

Luke 22:69 Here after shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.

Acts 5:31 Him hath God exalted with his right hand *to be* a Prince and a Savior, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

Acts 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,
56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.

Romans 8:34 Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Hebrews 1:3 Who being the brightness of *his* glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

Hebrews 1:13 But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool?

Hebrews 8:1 Now of the things which we have spoken *this is* the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

Hebrews 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;

Hebrews 12:2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of *our* faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

1 Peter 3:22 Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

I conclude this part by saying that *Jesus Christ already functioned as Mediator in the Old Testament era*. He did not wait until His Incarnation to become the Mediator. He was already the God-Man before the Incarnation, even from Pre-Creative Eternity.

Psalms 80:17 Let thy hand be upon the man of thy right hand, upon the son of man *whom* thou madest strong for thyself.

Psa. (109:4) The Lord swore, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever, after the order of Melchisedec.

5 (109:5) *The Lord at thy right hand has dashed in pieces kings in the day of his wrath.*

Jesus Christ is identified in the New Testament as the Mediatorial-Judge. He already did this as the Man of God's Right Hand in the Old Testament. This is not only further proof of Christ's pre-existence as the God-Man, but His previous existence as the Mediatorial-Judge under both Covenants, the Old and the New.
